 - Pre-production preparation







Roadmap on Adoption of BIM for Building Plan Preparation and Submission


Tentative Schedule for Launching the Enhanced ESH


- A) Mandatory e-submission of plans

- B) Mandatory e-submission of BIM generated plans and BIM model By 2029


