# **Summary of Decision of the Building Committee Building Committee I 22/2024 held on 10.9.2024**

## (a) MAI 1 22/2024

Issue : Surrender of land for street widening in return for bonus plot ratio

and site coverage

Decision : Noting that there was no objection from concerned departments, the

committee agreed to grant bonus plot ratio and site coverage in return

for the proposed surrender of land.

## (b) MAI 2 22/2024

Issue : Alternative design for waiving low zone assessment for building

separation.

Decision : Noting that the alternative approach generally met the criteria set out

in PNAP APP-152, the committee agreed to waive the building

separation design requirement at the low zone.

#### (c) <u>BCI 1 22/2024</u>

Issue : Application for hotel concession.

Decision : Noting that the proposal generally met the criteria set out in PNAP

APP-40, the committee had no objection in-principle to grant hotel

concession under B(P)R 23A.

#### (d) BCI 2 22/2024

Issue : Footbridge projecting over street.

Decision : Having regard to the circumstance of the case, the committee had no

objection to permit the proposed footbridge to be built over street.

## (e) <u>BCI 3 22/2024</u>

Issue : (i) Determination of street under PNAP APP-152.

(ii) Excessive site coverage of the podium above 15m from mean

street level

(iii) Exclusion of aboveground carparks and loading and

unloading areas from GFA calculation.

- (iv) High headroom of communal sky gardens.
- (v) Exclusion of covered Public Open Space from GFA calculation.

Decision :

- (i) Having considered the site circumstances, the committee accepted the street for assessment of building separation and building setback requirements.
- (ii) Noting that the proposal generally met the criteria set out in PNAP APP-101, the committee agreed to permit excessive site coverage of the podium above 15m from mean street level.
- (iii) Having considered the site circumstances and AP's justifications, the committee agreed to grant 100% GFA concession for the aboveground carparks and loading and unloading areas.
- (iv) Having considered the AP's justifications, the committee had no objection to accept the proposed high headroom.
- (v) Having regard to the circumstances of the case, the committee agreed to exclude the covered Public Open Space from GFA calculation.

#### (f) BCI 4 22/2024

Issue : Formal appeal against the decision of the Building Authority.

Decision : Having considered the case, the committee agreed to contest the appeal.
